Primary Role

- Observe, document, train and provide feedback to MSG staff and third-party vendors as well as contractors performing work at the facility
- · Lead all near miss and actual EH&S incidents and accidents analysis and corrective/preventative measures
- Perform required H&S inspections, Job Site Observation (JSO) and OBA's
- Routinely perform audits in EH&S areas of maintenance, water and wastewater facilities for regulatory and company policy compliance, prepare audit findings and ensure closure/corrective actions
- · Assist in the preparation of all permit applications, preparation of regulatory reports, provide monthly EH&S and Compliance reporting
- Provide support, sample validation reports, Lab QA/QC documentation, and interact/reporting (as necessary) with regulatory agencies (approved by manager)
- · Perform other duties as assigned
