The Collection Systems Supervisor, for the Wastewater-Collections Department, performs supervisory work of a difficult nature involving the construction, operation, maintenance and repairs of the collection system. Work is performed under the general direction of the Collection System Superintendent. Exercises supervision over skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled laborers and construction personnel. May be assigned full or partial responsibility in the absence of the Collection Systems Superintendent.

Education: High school graduate or high school equivalency certificate.

Experience: Four years of experience in sewer collection system operation, maintenance and construction with one year in a lead worker, group leader, supervisory, or position involving instructing others.

License & Certification: C-2 Waste System Operators Certification within one year of appointment. Requires a valid Maryland Commercial Driver's license with satisfactory driving record.

Essential Functions: Examples of duties but are not limited to: Organizes work and directs personnel assigned on variety of construction, operations, maintenance and repair projects in the Collection System; Supervises the installation, replacement, repair, adjustment and maintenance of sewer main, lateral, connections, pumping stations, flushing, T.V., flow monitoring, force main, manholes and other related equipment and materials; Responsible for evaluating employee performance and recommending disciplinary action; Oversees the proper care and use of tools and equipment; Supervises customer service work; Other duties as assigned.
