Just hold a valid operator's certificate that the Maryland State Board of Waterworks and Waste Systems Operators considers appropriate for either wastewater class 5 or water class 4, a passing score on both an operator certification examination that the Board accepts for wastewater class 5, and an operator certification examination that the Board accepts for water class 4, a passing score on a third operator certification examinations that the Maryland State Board of Waterworks and Waste Systems Operators has accepted for operator certification in this State. This third examination must be passed within 24 months of beginning employment in the Maryland Environmental Service's water/wastewater environmental systems operator job series.
